IT'S SAID THAT HANS WAS RARELY EVER WITHOUT HIS SCISSORS AND PAPER, READY TO ENTERTAIN FRIENDS AND THEIR CHILDREN WITH HIS WHIMSICAL DESIGNS. THERE ARE HUNDREDS OF THESE SPECTACULAR PAPER PIECES AND I'VE ALREADY SPENT HOURS LOOKING AT THEM. I LOVE WHEN AN ARTIST EXPLORES OTHER FORMS OF EXPRESSION. AND I THINK IT'S REMARKABLE THAT MANY MANY YEARS LATER PICASSO AND MATISSE ALSO EXPLORED THIS FORM OF ART. I THINK I MIGHT JUST BE NEXT.

#### FROM THE MUSEUM ODENSE IN DENMARK --

THROUGH OUT HIS LIFE HANS CHRISTIAN ANDERSEN WAS AN ADDICT TO PAPER. HE WROTE ON IT, HE DREW ON IT AND HE USED IT TO CUT IN. LIKE THE ANCIENT EXPRESSION THAT FORM AND ART IS HIDDEN IN THE STONE, ONLY TO BE REVEALED BY THE SCULPTOR. THE POET USED HIS MATERIAL, THE PAPER, TO ENGRAVE, OR RATHER TO CARVE OUT HIS IDEAS WITH INK AND MORE RADICALLY HE USED HIS SCISSORS TO CUT OUT THE MOST ELEGANT FIGURES.





#### SOFT AND CHEWY AMARETTI COOKIES

I'M NOT ITALIAN BUT I GREW UP EATING THESE COOKIES AROUND THE HOLIDAYS. YOU KNOW THE ONES THAT COME WRAPPED IN THAT BEAUTIFUL PRINTED PAPER? THOSE ARE A DRY AND CRUNCHY AND ARE SUPER DELICIOUS WITH A CUP OF COFFEE. THESE ARE MY VERSION, I LOVE THESE CHEWY ALMOND MOUNDS. THEY ARE PERFECT IN A HOLIDAY COOKIE BOX AND LAST IN AN AIR TIGHT CONTAINER FOREVER.

140g granulated sugar, plus more for rollingZest of 1 lemonZest of 1 orange165g. almond flour2 large egg whites1 tsp. almond extract1 tsp. amaretto liqueur

1/4 tsp. orange blossom water (optional but it's wondeful)

In a medium bowl, rub together sugar and zests using your fingertips until sugar turns a pale orange shade. Whisk in almond flour until well combined.

In a large bowl using a hand mixer, beat egg whites until medium peaks form. Add in almond extract, amaretto, orange blossom water (if using), and almond flour mixture and fold to combine. Store dough in an airtight container for at least 2 hours, up to overnight.

When ready to bake, preheat oven to 325°. Line a baking sheet with parchment.

Portion dough into balls about 1 tablespoonful each, sometimes I wet my hands lightly to keep the dough from sticking. Roll in more granulated sugar before placing on prepared sheet 2" apart.

Bake until bottoms are lightly golden, about 23 to 25 minutes.


